Dear Attorney General Suthers:

On February 17, 2010, you received notice of my intent to take personal action against Policy Studies, Inc., the delegate child support enforcement unit for the El Paso County Department of Human Services. The notice stated I would take action by March 5, 2010 and requested that you initiate an investigation of the unlawful conduct of PSI in the handling of my case. As court records reflect, I have filed numerous pleadings since March 2, 2010.

The February notice to you was followed by my March 10<sup>th</sup> fax that made a second request for an independent investigation and included a copy of the pleading filed on March 9<sup>th</sup> to assist you.
