and the Register of Actions form marked and stamped by the supervising clerk on April 16, 2010 to demonstrate that the mishandling of court records should not be used by attorney Eigel to support her untimely and unacceptable response to the Petition mailed to her on April 8, 2010. Additionally of note, the supervising clerk refused to sign the Register of Actions form, and Attorney Eigel's Response failed to acknowledge the Second Extraordinary Motion for Change of Venue filed on March 11, 2010 that coincided with the fraudulent notice of lien and levy served on American National Bank by the Colorado Division of Child Support Enforcement showing El Paso as the enforcing county on March 11, 2010.
